HEALTH REMINDERS...

As the cold weather settles in we see an increase in the incidence of illness.

I would like to remind you to help us in tracking these illnesses in our school. Please call the school when your child has been diagnosed with strep throat, pink eye, pneumonia, and flu. Also, I ask that you follow the guidelines as outlined in the student handbook for keeping your child home when he/she is ill.

- This means students do not return to school until they are fever-free for 24 hours.
- If a student vomits, they need to wait 24 hours before returning to school.
- If you have questions about whether or not your child is able to return to school, feel free to give us a call.

Headlice - The parent or guardian has the ultimate responsibility to ensure children are free of lice and nits. It is recommended that you check your child's head often for lice and/or nits.
