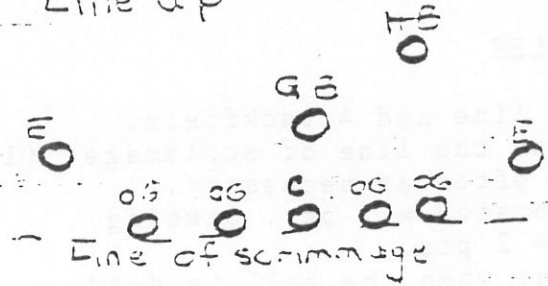

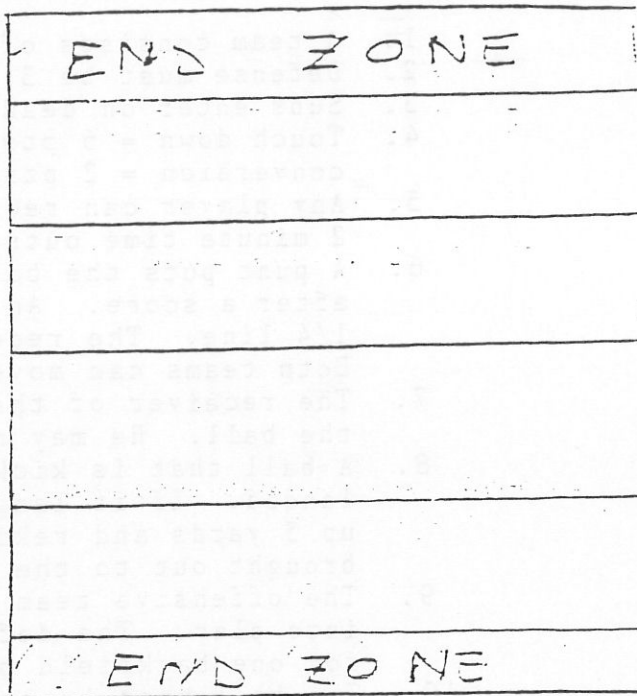

- QB - Quarter back - call plays and receives snap from the center.
- HB - Halfback - runs the called plays, receives passes.
- C - Center - snaps ball to the quarterback, receives passes.
- E - End - Runs called plays, receives pass or hand off.
- OG - Offensive guard - protects ball carrier.

- DG - Defensive guard - rushes ball carrier.
- DHB - Defensive halfback - covers potential pass receivers.
- S - safety - covers all players who penetrate past the defense.

Terms

1. Centering - putting the ball in play other than by a kick off.
2. Down - a unit of the game which starts when the ball is centered and ends when the ball is dead.
3. End zone - The area between the goal and end line.
4. Forward pass - A pass thrown by any player from behind the line of scrimmage and towards the opponents goal.
5. Fumble - A dropped ball, downed immediately.
6. Huddle - 2 or more players conferring between downs.
7. Own goal - The goal your team defends.
8. Pass interference - preventing a player from catching a pass by pushing, holding, or any illegal method.
9. Touchback - A punt or kickoff that lands in the end zone and is brought out to the 1/4 line.
10. Neutral zone - The 3 yard area between the offense and defense.
11. Safety - An offensive player is downed in his own end zone. The defense gets 2 points.
12. Offense - The team with the ball.
13. Defense - The without the ball.
